Subject:- Implementation of PWIMS in Punjab Irrigation Department

As you are aware, Public Works Information Management System (PWIMS) for the purpose of online Measurement Book, was under preparation for last few years. Now three modules of this system (Contract Management, Measurement Book Management and Bill Management) have been finalized. Before finalization, this system has been tested and examined at various levels. The final presentation of this software was made in a meeting under the chairmanship of Secretary/irrigation on 07.06.16 wherein the department officers were by and large satisfied with performance of the software. The basic objectives of this system are as follows:-


- Accurate and efficient project management
- Reduced project cycle time
- Improved access to information for better decision making & improved cost management
- Transparency in the activities of the Department
- Improved services to the stakeholders

Therefore it has been decided to implement these three modules of the system in toto in the department w.e.f. 15<sup>th</sup> June, 2016 as per details mentioned below:-

1. This system can be accessed from Punjab Irrigation department's official website or by use of following direct link: <http://irrigation.punjab.gov.in/pwims.aspx>
2. All works starting after 15<sup>th</sup> of June, 2016 should be mandatorily uploaded into PWIMS system and Measurement books should be filled online into the system only. Bill as generated by this system should be used for sending it to treasuries.
3. All such works where current progress is less than 30% and they are to get completed after 30<sup>th</sup> Sep. 2016 be uploaded online as well and Measurement books should be filled online into the system only. Bill as generated by this system should be used for sending it to treasuries.

4. J.E.s are required to fill M.B. online within 3 days of making the entry. In case of any further delay, JE will be required to enter reason for the delay.
5. HPE (implementing agency) has deployed 35 Technical Executives at different locations across Punjab, List of which along with their telephone numbers is available at [www.irrigation.punjab.gov.in/pwims.aspx](http://www.irrigation.punjab.gov.in/pwims.aspx). Additionally a centralised helpdesk is being created at Computer Cell, Irrigation H.O. Sector-18, Chandigarh where technical executives will be available from 9 AM to 5 PM on all working days to assist field officials. Their contact details are as under:-
